Location: Redmond High School, 675 SW Rimrock Dr., Redmond OR 97756

Weigh Ins: Friday April 9th 8 pm, or 7:30-8am Saturday, April 10th

Fight Night: We will have a 2 hour open mat/practice for teams arriving on Friday night (see the schedule below). We will also allow teams to stay on the mats w/ adult supervision. Please contact us in advance to arrange for overnight stay.

Schedule: (This is a list of estimated times. Times are subject to change based on the number of teams attending. An updated schedule will be sent out when teams are confirmed.)

Friday:

6-8pm	Match Night—Wrestlers can pair up and wrestle Freestyle or Greco matches in an informal setting. Coaches/Kids will need to officiate.
8pm	Weigh-ins for teams arriving on Friday

Saturday:

7:30-8am	Weigh-ins for teams arriving on Saturday
9am	Round 1
10:30am	Round 2
12:00pm	Round 3
1:30pm	Round 4
3:00pm	Round 5—Championship Round

Format: Duals with teams competing in a round robin pooled format with top scoring teams matched up for a championship bout.

Food and Lodging: You may be able to stay on the mats if you contact us in advance, otherwise, this is your responsibility.

Payment: Make Check Payable to Redmond Wrestling Club for \$225 and mail to Nathan Stanley, RHS Wrestling, 675 SW Rimrock Dr., Redmond, OR 97756 or go to www.rhswrestling.com/blog/post. Payments must be made by March 26th. No refunds.

Each team may bring 22 wrestlers: No more than 22 wrestlers a team, no exceptions. We will stick extras on unfilled teams. All extras will be put into the tournament.

Match limit: This is not a National Federation Tournament and the time is adjusted, be prepared to wrestle with limited rest.

Rest time: Your rest time is from dual to dual. During the tournament your rest period is the time between your match and whenever you are called next.

Ref responsibility: Each team must provide one (1) adult that will help ref and time Dual Matches. One ref will keep time, while the other ref will officiate. We will try and supply some certified officials, however, we will not be able to run the tournament in a timely manner without the help of coaches officiating.

Scoring: The official will keep time via a time watch. Score will be kept by each team. There is no scoring table.

Disputes: If there is a dispute in the score the ref will try to resolve it. If it cannot be resolved, it will come down to a coin flip. There is no protest committee. You must live with the official's decision. Please keep in mind for \$500 the mat time is a bargain in itself!

Uniforms: You may not use high school uniforms. You must have a club singlet, no exceptions. Red and Blue Freestyle Singlets are preferred.

Insurance: This tournament is insured by The Camp Team and is NOT a USA Wrestling sanctioned tournament. This means USA cards are NOT REQUIRED.

Packet: Let me know if you need another packet ASAP!

Bring An Official: Do not come without an adult, coach, or parent to officiate the duals.

Time: Duals 2-2-2 (USA Wrestling Junior Division Rules)

Weight Classes: 84, 91, 98, 105, 112, 119, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 152, 160, 171, 189, 215, 285

Teams: Your average team has JV, middle school, and varsity combined, all are welcome.

Awards: There will be trophies for the top Middle/High School Combined Team and the top High School only team. High School only squads will compete against combined teams, but only 105-285 will be calculated in their team score.

Ref responsibility: Each team must provide one (1) adult that will help ref and time Dual Matches. One ref will keep time, while the other ref will officiate. We will try and supply some certified officials, however, we will not be able to run the tournament in a timely manner without the help of coaches officiating. If you do not have an adult who can referee, we will charge an additional \$50 to provide an official.

Scoring: The official will keep time via a time watch. Score will be kept by each team. There is no scoring table.

Disputes: If there is a dispute in the score the ref will try to resolve it. If it cannot be resolved, it will come down to a coin flip. There is no protest committee. You must live with the official's decision. Please keep in mind for \$200 the mat time is a bargain in itself!

Hotel Info: You are responsible to make your lodging arrangements. The mats will be available on Friday, however, this must be pre-arranged and adults must supervise at all time.
